Watch Out for Freerolls

Freerolls are a good way to play poker tournaments without having to pay a joining fee, so to speak. Although most freerolls are actually free, hence the term, there are certain conditions you have to follow before you can play. For instance, some require a certain number of points before you can avail of the freerolls; others require you to download the full version of their software, for online poker sites. There are also sign-up requirements sometimes for links provided by the freeroll giver. While you may consider these conditions as being a bit tricky, you must remember that freerolls are held as promotional events so that more people would get a poker room's software or so that the poker room can earn your patronage.

Learn Your Game

Poker sites, poker news online and other channels usually have a list of legitimate freerolls, complete with the site's links and the conditions if there are any. This decreases the search process and actually gives the player an idea if he wants to avail of a certain site's freeroll, and also to compare which software providers have the best freeroll promo.

There are also freeroll multi-table tourneys that not only give away cash prizes, they also give points that could earn players a ticket to the next tourney. However, as these are basically free, you may want to keep watch when one is coming and sign up early as these kinds of tournaments have the tendency to fill up quickly.

You may want to be a little skeptical about sites that claim to have absolutely FREE freerolls! There are catches, most of the time. The best way to avail of a freeroll is to get them from legitimate sites with legitimate poker software. You may have to pay a sign-up fee, which you could actually get back – you could learn more about it from your provider – so it's actually a better deal than getting freerolls from nobodies; you just might regret this later on.
